ecoWise Holdings Ltd (“ecoWise”) is developing a Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) project on “Supply and Use of Thermal Energy”. The energy for this proposed project will come from renewable natural resources and is part of ecoWise commitment to play an active part in the reduction of Green House Gases (GHG) produced from the burning of fossil fuels.

The project activity aims at developing on-site thermal energy intensive related activities to make use of the steam through:

- Spent grain drying (main application)
- ISO tank heating/cleaning

This will result in reduced emissions of GHGs as the energy generated is from sustainable resources.

Environmental, social and economic benefits will be generated as a result of the use of alternative energy. This includes knowledge transfer and development of the hardware and softwares involved in the setting up and operations of the new activities.
